Essential industry specific qualifications and experience

Up-to-date, relevant, and broad experience of working in one or more of the industry areas industries, including current knowledge of working practices, legislation and policy within the sector for this apprenticeship standard.

Essential qualifications and experience

Must have at least three years' work experience in the sector and at least the same level as the apprenticeship. This means they are capable of carrying out the full requirements within the competence they are assessing; possessing knowledge, understanding, experience and skills relevant to the Standard being assessed.

Must include having current knowledge of relevant legislation, regulation, codes of practice and good practice guides.

Clearly demonstrate continuing learning and professional development of at least five days per year.

Must be qualified to at least the level they are assessing

Must hold a formal assessor qualification at, or equivalent to, Regulated Qualification Framework level 3.

Must have the expertise to administer the assessment tools required.
